Dear Woodbridge School District Community,

Please find below important health and safety updates related to this past week:


- First, we continue to thank you for keeping your child home from school when your child feels sick, or has a fever, runny nose, or shortness of breath. Additionally, your child should come to Beecher with a mask that fits well over his/her nose and mouth.
- Continued contact-tracing provides transparent communication to our staff and families of potential exposure they had to other individuals with COVID-19. Since my last communication in this regard (January 28), we have contact-traced based on notifications that 5 members of our community tested positive for COVID-19, and were at Beecher Road School when potentially contagious:

- We continue to have a supply of COVID-19 rapid self-test kits for use by children who: (a) have had direct “close contact” exposure to an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19; or (b) are exhibiting symptoms and need to be screened for COVID-19. If your child falls into either category and you need a test, please [e-mail our Nursing Supervisor, Ms. Robin Froehle, RN](#), who will approve your request, place your name on the test pickup list, and advise you of test pickup protocols.
- If your child tests positive for COVID-19, please continue to e-mail all of the following three individuals so that we can advise you timely on next steps related to your child’s education: BRS Principal Analisa Sherman (asherman@woodbridgeps.org); BRS Assistant Principal Jimmy Sapia (jsapia@woodbridgeps.org); and Superintendent Jonathan Budd (jbudd@woodbridgeps.org).
