Fast and accurate communication with school is essential in today's challenging times. Fortunately, Beecher Road School has a notification system that can alert you to important news and information. These messages could vary from general announcements about upcoming events, to an emergency closing. You control the type of information that you would like to receive and how you would like to get it. The growth of our educational program and the safety of our children is dependent on your participation in this system.

A test of the Instant Alert system will take place on Wednesday, November 4th. It is imperative that you register and/or update your information before that date. The Honeywell Instant Alert for Schools is easy to sign onto and provides you with a wide variety of message alerts:

RED – Emergency Notifications

- Emergency closing
- Other emergencies

ORANGE – No School Announcements

- School cancellation
- Delayed opening or early dismissal (weather)

YELLOW – Transportation Alerts

- Bus delays
- Other items that impact transportation

GREEN – General Announcements

- Upcoming minimum/conference days
- Newsletters
- Superintendent Updates

You can control how you receive this information. You can get it via phone, cell phone, pager, PDA, e-mail and cell text. You may choose different methods of alert for different levels. For example, you may choose to get GREEN announcements via e-mail, but would like RED alerts sent to your cell phone, home phone, and work phone.

It is our goal that every parent will participate in this valuable system. All you have to do is log onto the website <https://instantalert.honeywell.com> and set up your account. If you already have an account, you can update your selections and take advantage of all the types of messages.
